Agreement to Change the Deadline for Submitting Article 15 Decisions to Arbitration July 14, 2016

The University and the AAUP-WSU agree that upon being notified of a Bargaining Unit Faculty Member's termination or suspension pursuant to Article 15 of the NTE or TET CBA, the AAUP-WSU will have forty (40) days to submit the decision to arbitration. Accordingly, Section 15.16 of the TET CBA and Section 15.5.14 of the NTE CBA are hereby modified as follows:

At the sole discretion of the AAUP-WSU, the final decision may be taken directly to binding arbitration within <u>forty (40) days after receiving notice of the decision.</u> The <u>All other</u> timelines, procedures and the costs of arbitration will be governed by the provisions concerning arbitration in Sections <u>16.6.1 through 16.6.4.5</u>.
